### Workshop description:

Are you writing a Master's thesis in **Biology**, **Chemistry**, **Cognitive Science** or **Physics** in the Summer Semester, 2015, or the Winter Semester, 2015-16?

This *Schreibwerkstatt* workshop will address writing a Master's thesis in English that uses empirical research. Using authentic texts, this workshop will raise awareness about the conventions of academic writing in specific fields and provide writers with a toolkit of academic phrases and collocations for their own writing.

Participants will be able to:

- Identify and navigate some of the differences between German and English academic writing
- Use and contribute to a toolkit of academic phrases and collocations
- Review some "common" and "field specific" academic language
- Break down, analyze and practice the ways in which researchers use texts to communicate their findings
- Plan a realistic research and writing schedule
- Receive feedback on their own writing
